



Autodesk Software Installation Instructions

Before you start we recommend that you...

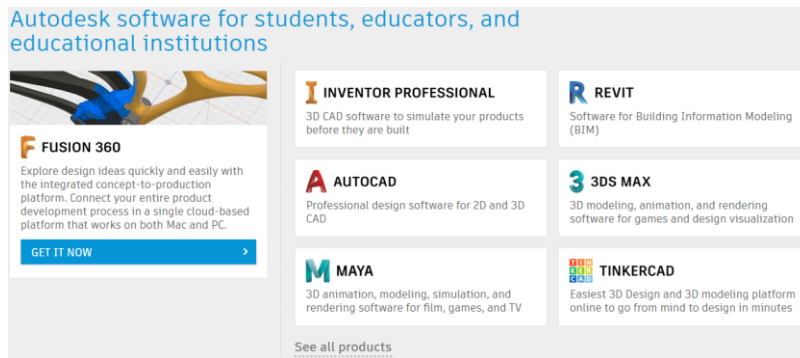
- Plan on not moving your laptop for the next 2-3 hours
- Plug your laptop in to a reliable power source
- Plug into a wired network with an Ethernet cable, or have a strong, reliable, wireless internet
- **Turn on** presentation mode while downloading and installing the software to ensure your computer stays on
 - **Windows** key + X ( + ) and select **Mobility Center**

Autodesk Account Registration

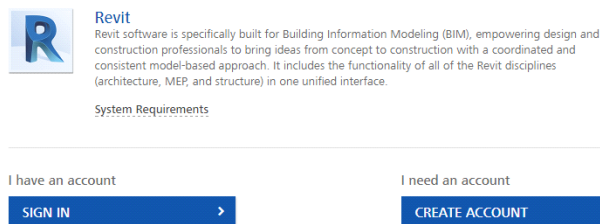
1. Go to <https://accounts.autodesk.com/register>
 - a. You will need to enter your school, birthday, and the timeframe you will be in school
 - b. **Note:** Be sure to use your full Marquette e-mail when signing up (firstname.lastname@marquette.edu)

Downloading Autodesk Software

1. <https://www.autodesk.com/education/free-software/all>
2. You will be directed to a page with a list of the software available to students as seen below



3. Select the software you need on the quick menu, or select **See all products** to view more
4. When you click on the software you need, you will be directed to a software product page where you may need to sign in or sign up for an Autodesk Student Account



- a. If you have an account already, click **Sign In** and use your existing credentials. If you skipped the first section and do not have an existing account, click **Create Account** and fill out the form
5. Select the **2018** version, operating system type, and language

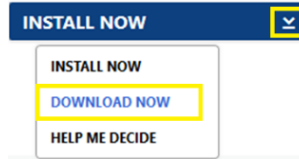

- a. **Note:** if you are unsure of your computers operating system architecture you can always go to **Start** on Windows and search for **System** and look under **System Type**

- After choosing language and operating system options, you will be given a **serial number** and **product key** that is specific to your Autodesk account; **keep these on hand for use later in the installation**

Product key: xxxxx

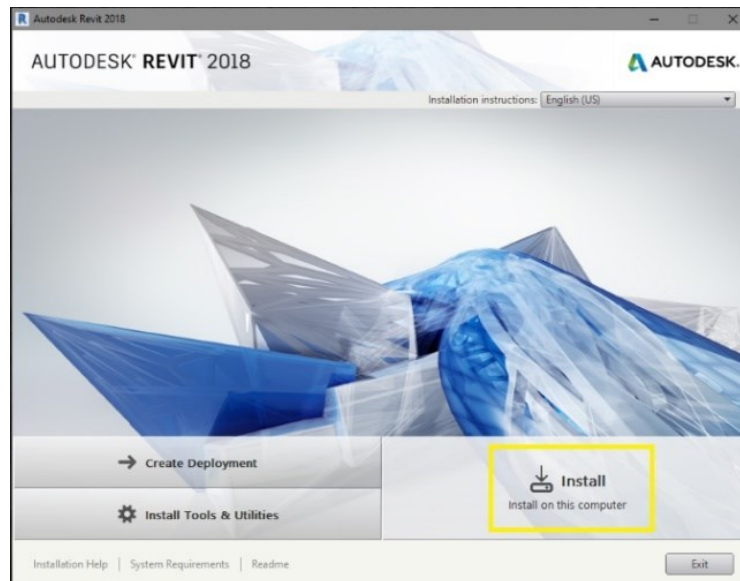
- To start downloading your software, select **Download Now** from the dropdown menu



A multi-gigabyte install file should begin downloading in a download manager. This may take some time to finish downloading, just make sure that you keep the manager running and have a reliable internet connection. If you're unable to download via wireless, please try plugging in to the much faster wired network instead.

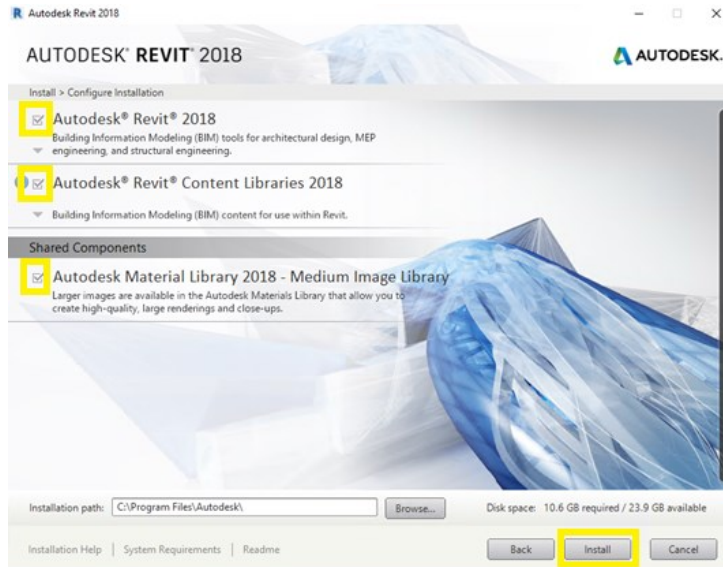
Installing Autodesk Software

- Once the download is complete, double click the file to start installation
- You will be prompted to extract files to C:\Autodesk\; select **OK** to start
- Once extraction is complete it should automatically start the install
 - If not, go to the extracted file location and run **Setup.exe**
- Accept any Windows installation permission dialogues that may appear
- The installer application should open, and click the **Install** button to continue

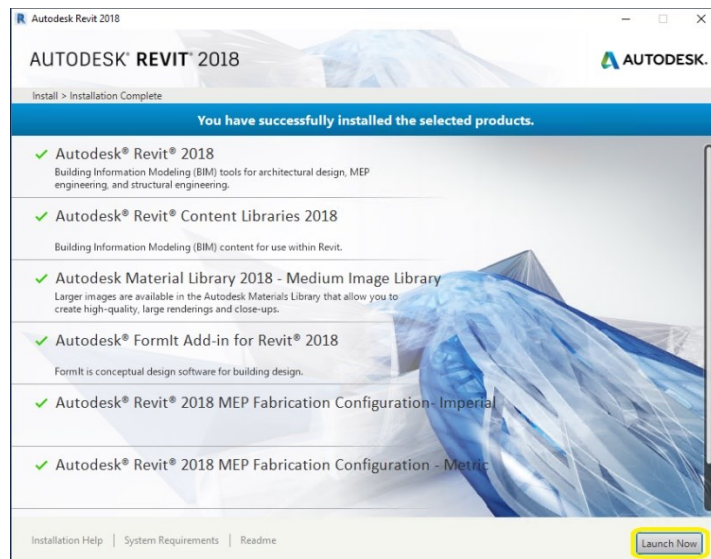


- Read through the license info and **accept** to continue

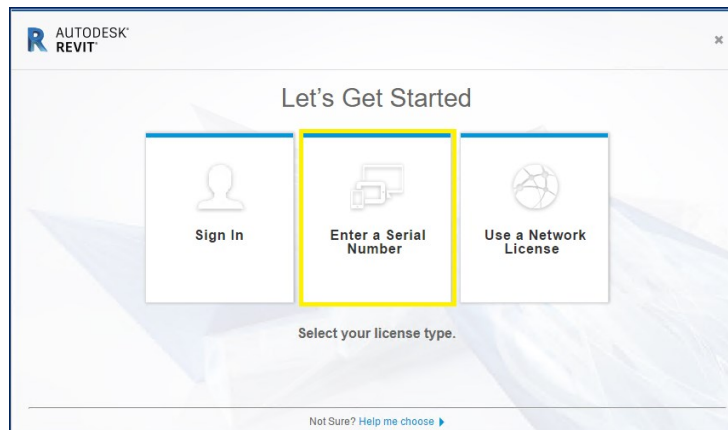
7. Verify the needed major categories are checked, then click **Install** to start the installation



8. Once the installation has completed, select **Launch Now** to verify the installation works

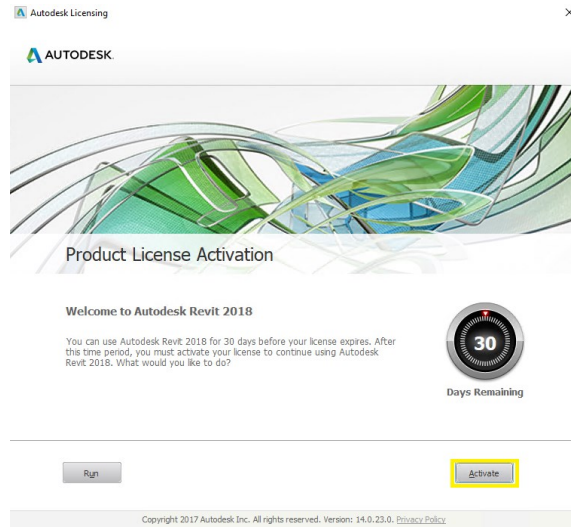


9. On the **Let's Get Started** window, select **Enter a Serial Number**



10. Yet another agreement window will greet you, **accept** it to continue

11. On the **Product License Activation**, select **Activate**



12. This next window is where you will need to enter the **serial number** and **product key** you received earlier; click **Next** to finish
